- After selecting relevant option click on "Upload students" button enter your school Dice/college code and export/download student details with register numbers without fail.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE GUIDANCE OF THE CHIEF SUPERINTENDENT

#### GENERAL

- The Chief Superintendent will be in charge of conducting the Examination at each centre of Examination
- 2. The examination will be of 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours duration from 10.30 a.m. to 12.Noon
- 3. The Examination may be conducted generally on lines of the S.S.L.C Public Examination
- 4. Check the number of question booklets
- 5. Candidates to bring their own writing materials (i.e., pen or ball pen.)
- Voluntary services of members of Junior Red Cross, NCC/NSS Scouts and Guides may be utilized for serving drinking water etc., if necessary
- The counselors of the school Junior Red Cross wing , may be utilized for conducting the examination

#### ADMISSION TICKETS:-

Admission tickets of all the candidates are enclosed herewith. This may be kindly checked with the nominal roll. Any discrepancies observed may be reported immediately. The school seal may be affixed on the admission tickets at the appropriate place to indicate the Centre of Examination. Admission tickets may be distributed to the Candidates well in time, after writing the names of candidate with respective Register Number.

#### **OPENING OF QUESTION BOOKLET COVER:-**

Required number of booklets will be sent in sealed packet, which may be kept in the safe custody of the Chief Superintendent. This may be opened NOT EARLIER THAN 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE EXAMINATION and distributed to the Room Supervisors according to requirements.
